


Jim Kohlmann

Jim Kohlmann was born in the Midwest in the 1940's under unusual circumstances. When he entered college he became an atheist, joining some of the most active far-left organizations existing at the time.

After many years of this, he had a remarkable salvation experience in 1971 through the healing power of God. Having emerged from the struggle of dealing with his origins, he has been teaching his course called "Personal Restoration in Christ" for two decades to groups large and small. He is an Orlando businessman, also serving as worship leader, Bible teacher and public speaker in various venues. In Miami and later in Orlando, he was a radio talk show host focused on civic issues. His emphasis is now on regional transformation that is occurring worldwide as believers seek God for His presence and favor. 
