esley admits he comes from poor yet proud *Virginia roots*. His grandmother and mother were a major influence in his life.

Wesley saw something in them that he wanted to emulate at a very young age.

He explains: "I first heard the voice of God at a preschool age and began keeping conversations with Him late into the night. God invited me to the alter for a public confession at the age of eight. This went unnoticed by the congregation because I was in church 3 times a week anyway."

He goes on to say: "Prophetic dreams started with details of an uncle's funeral two weeks before his death. I described what I thought were Roman soldiers because I had never seen a "Mason" funeral before. Another dream involved an earthquake in the Mississippi River Valley reaching Cincinnati with walls of fire leaping from the ground in northern Mississippi. Thank God that one hasn't happened yet.

I lived in a region that placed little value on education which left me short on self-esteem. I didn't socialize much. The Lord asked me not to date any of the *local girls* so I didn't. I met my wife (Mary) at a church camp meeting. She lived 80 miles away which seemed far enough. Our marriage has lasted for 44 years. No regrets, only joy.

Mary and I came to Florida in 1972 where we attended Bible College. I officially became a drop-out. In the early 1976 I asked our local congregation to pray for my mind. I was dyslexic and couldn't read. Within two weeks I began writing a 63,000 word manuscript. Spelling is still a problem, but writing is a passion.

I can claim the extraordinary of the ordinary. Sometimes, after months of boredom, miracles happen. In Christ I have seen visions of Heaven; talked personally with The Lord; fraught personally with the devil; been healed of scarlet fever, allergy to bees, heart disease, chronic bronchitis, shattered bones and multiple brown recluse spider bites.

I have stood inside exploding gasoline, physically passed through a speeding car; turned a hurricane with a few simple words, I have seen prayers answered for cancer being healed overnight, teeth being filled, demons evicted, and insanity fixed physical fire appearing on command over seven hundred miles away as confirmation to a spiritual warfare prayer.

The greatest miracle was when God saved me from myself. The most difficult miracle is accepting myself in His Righteousness, knowing I have none of my own. I have felt suicidal, depressed, tempted, angry and unclean, **But** God keeps waiting with His hand out to pick me up and keep me moving. I am not a part of the church system. I am a subject of a Kingdom. Knowledge brings great heaviness, responsibility and little favor from church builders. Revival will either grows in stony ground, fertilized by true prophets blood or the broken ground fertilized by the blood of the false prophets. Moves of God happen when people forget to be anything but humble and desperate. Knowing God's heart means feeling His broken heart!


