In August of 2000, Gail Sullivan answered God's call, and moved her family to Sarasota FL. She originally hails from the Boston-Rhode Island area ~ which you'd discover rather quickly from her distinct accent. It was in Rhode Island, in 1984, that Gail entered into a divine partnership with God, and has been serving Him ever since. She started in an internship program in her local church, and ultimately became the co-pastor of their first church plant in East Providence RI ~ Grace Chapel Assembly of God ~ from 1987 . 1995. That church is still in operation.

Gail has been successful in both the Christian and secular arenas, from Christian school teacher to Investment Advisor, coach, speaker, author and entrepreneur. With all that said, our sister remarks that the most rewarding and most difficult job has been the role of Mother. Gail's children are now all adults who love the LORD with all their hearts. She sees that as her greatest success!

In January of 2013, God beckoned Gail to step into a spiritual endeavor she refers to as The Red Shoe Project. For 536 days, Gail put on RED shoes to remind herself to look and listen for God everyday ~ blogging about what she discovered each night before going to bed. That blog is soon to become six powerful books on

walking with the Holy Spirit ~ the first due out by the beginning of 2017.

For the last five years, Gail has faithfully assisted her spiritual mother, Bonnie Joy Kelley, at The Bonfire ~ a multi-denominational group of over 70 Christian women who meet monthly to give God their highest praise, feed on His Word and move in the flow of the Holy Spirit.

Most recently, Gail participated in Revive FLORIDA ~ a movement geared towards winning the cities of Sarasota and Bradenton, and ultimately our state for Christ. As she continues to raise funds for support as a missionary with Time To Revive, she is hard at work, assisting another of her local mentors, Rueben Beachy, in setting up a culture of discipleship in our community. You will find her in a variety of places training up disciples in preparation for a great move of God in our city.

As of late, God has also commissioned Gail to pull together an army of prayer warriors ~ specifically in Sarasota. She comments, *"This is perhaps the most overwhelming divine assignment I've ever been given, but God has assured me that all I need to do is follow His lead. He will surface key people to assist me and He, Himself, will call in the soldiers."*

Gail is the author of **The Yellow Brick Road: A Woman's Journey to the Edge and Back**, Course studies on **Blood Covenant** and **Body, Soul & Spirit**, and the up and coming series entitled, **The Red Shoe Project: A Woman's Search for More of God.**

With all her experiences as a woman, Christian, mother and businesswoman, Gail has stepped up to the next challenge God has presented to her, and is sharing her life stories with women to bring encouragement, laughter, growth and hope. Her book, **The Yellow Brick Road**, is an amazing story of faith. She describes how God hung on to her when she couldn't hold on any longer.
